Gorakhpur University at University center . Admission test will consist of design Objective and Aptitude test followed by any interview.

Reservation in admission: Reservation system for admission will be as per the University norms. However, two seats will be reserved for ex - students of the Dept. of Fine Arts and Music who are in university / college service in any capacity.

Admission Fees and Registration: After qualifying the admission test, candidates will be intimated through the departmental notice board and newspapers. Candidates are required to pay fees in one installment for each academic session. Students who leave the Diploma Programme for reasons

whatsoever after joining, will forfeit the entire fees and all charges. Fee is payable before the commencement of each academic year.
