EMBLEM

The University emblem consisting of two concentric circles, with the inner circle divided into two halves, one half showing the rising sun the other depicting the waters and a hundred petalled lotus emanating there from symbolises the biunity of knowledge and action, whole and part and time eternity. The Rigvedic hymn in the space between the upper circumferences of the two circles is a prayer to all powers auspicious, and an invocation of all intentions noble, all actions good and all wisdom serene.

The circle, the sun, the waters and the lotus in the emblem are all archetypes of wholeness. The mandala is a familiar motive of Indian art and iconography. The vedic supernal sun and the surface of the mythic lotus are circular in shape (mandalakara).

The supernal sun is verily the Person (Purusha) the Divine Being, the all-whole, divided into four part, one representing the three worlds of earth, sky and space (bhutani) and the remaining three, that is the major part representing Heaven and Immortality (amritam divi). It is this all-whole (akhanda mandalakaram) that the part (ams'a), that is man, perennially craves to unite with, through right knowledge and right action (Karatub).

The vedic hymn then expresses nothing more nor less than the universal human yearning for right knowledge, right intentions and right action (bhadrah kratavo) to come to him from all cosmic and supra cosmic corners. And it is this ideal of right intention that they seek to inculcate among their alumni.

The lotus is again the seat and seed-bed, in Indian mythology, of the goddess of knowledge (saraswati). The waters are the ultimate source from which all manifestations proceed and are appropriately depicted in myth and art as the residue (shesha), the irreducible unknown and unshown to which everything known and shown can be reduced. The residue (shesha) is analogically the non-residual (ashesha), the endless whole (ananta).

The traditional art motifs reproduced in the emblem only intend to express and reinforce the symbolism of the vedic hymn which our founding fathers had rightly selected as our motto.

4. The hard copy of the filled in application form need not be sent to the University.
5. To appear in the Entrance Test, the candidates must download the admit card from the University web site.
6. Candidates are required to keep the print (hardcopy) of the filled online application form, payment receipt and admit card with them.
7. The application fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.

3. General Rules for Admission to Various Post Graduation Programmes:

1. Application fee is non-refundable.
2. Application fee shall be charged on the dependents (husband/wife/son/daughter) of regular and serving teaching and non-teaching staff of the University.
3. Candidates need to apply separately for each Post Graduate programme.
4. Candidates are required to submit application fee separately for each programme for which they are applying.
5. In various programmes, the number of seats for admission in University Campus and affiliated Government/ Aided/ Self-Financed Colleges through the Joint Entrance Test being conducted by the University is predetermined. Admissions to Minority Colleges (if any) will be in accordance with Government Order No-2651/ Sattar-2-2003-1l61921/2002 Dated 02 July, 2003.
6. Candidates should thoroughly go through the PG Brochure/relevant Brochure before filling up the application form.
7. Candidates applying for MEd/ BPED programmes should thoroughly go through the concerned brochure before filling up the Application form.
8. Seventeen (17) years of age is the minimum age for admission in post graduate programmes.
9. All candidates aspiring admission in any programme shall be charged Rs 200.00 as counselling fee. The rate of counselling fee shall remain unchanged in case of the programmes where it had already been charged from earlier years/ sessions.





10. All admissions shall be done in order of merit against the seats available in different Post Graduation Programmes.
11. Entrance test shall not be conducted in those Post Graduation programmes where number of applicants is less than the number of seats available.
12. The merit lists declared by the university shall be final and binding.
13. If any document/declaration submitted by the candidate is found to be false/ forged at any stage of admission, his/ her admission shall be cancelled and he/she may be liable for prosecution under law.
14. University shall not be liable for any kind of error in filling up the application forms by the candidates. Any change in application form shall not be acceptable, later on.
15. Candidates, themselves must download their admit card, counselling letter/ allotment letter etc. from the university website.
16. Application submitted in one programme shall not be transferred to another programme.
17. The University reserves the right to make circumstantial changes in the rules of admission process in order to make it more effective and convenient.
18. More than one Post Graduate programmes can be combined for the purpose of entrance test.
19. Result of the Entrance Test declared by the University shall be final. There is no provision of re-valuation/scrutiny.





4. Reservation will be subject to the latest provisions of the Government (Only for University Campus and affiliated Government/Aided Colleges).

A. Vertical Reservation for Domicile of Uttar Pradesh only;

NOTE:

To get the benefit of reservation, candidates will have to produce the latest certificate issued by the competent authority of their district i.e. District Magistrate / Additional District Magistrate / Tehsildar, at the time of admission; otherwise claims on reservation may be rejected. Candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes are required to produce their latest Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority which clearly mentions that they do not fall under the Creamy Layer as per the State Government's latest provision. Reservation to the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) will be provided as per the government order no. Personnel Section -2 Number- 3/2019/4/12002/P-2/1914 dated 14 March, 2019.

It is to be informed that Government's latest reservation related mandates will be followed. Horizontal reservation shall be subject to produce the relevant certificates on prescribed format only.





5. Weightage for Joint Entrance Test:

(A)

- 02% for Women candidates.
- 02% for students having B/C Certificate in NCC.
- 02% for students of Scout/Guide/ Rover/Rangers
- 02% for the candidates who served 240 hours and took part at least in one special camp under NSS. This weightage is applicable only if the certificate is signed by the Vice Chancellor of the university.

NOTE:

- (i). Not more than two of the above-mentioned weightages shall be added together.
- (ii). No candidate shall be entitled to more than 04% weightage on the basis of any four of the above.

(B)

- (i) 10% weightage is admissible to unmarried son / daughter and wife / husband of retired / deceased regular teaching and non-teaching staff of the University Campus.
- (ii) 10% weightage is admissible to unmarried son / daughter and wife / husband of serving / retired / deceased regular teaching and non-teaching staff of the affiliated Government / Aided Colleges.

Note: The benefit of this weightage will be given only for admission in the University campus and affiliated Government / Aided Colleges. The maximum limit for weightage by combining (A) and (B) will be 10%.

(C)

- For the dependents (husband / wife / son / daughter) of regular teaching and non-teaching serving staff of the University, the maximum reservation is 10% of the total number of seats for admission in Post Graduate programmes. Applicants in the category will have to produce the Dependent Certificate issued by the Registrar to the Director, Admission Cell within the stipulated date. These admissions will be as per the reservation rules, availability of seats in the programme and marks scored in the Joint Entrance Test. No dependent will be admitted to the University without appearing in the Entrance Test. This facility is permissible only for the University Campus.
- There shall be no provision of seats for dependents (husband / wife / son / daughter) of regular teaching and non-teaching serving staff of the University campus and affiliated Government/Aided Colleges in M.Ed. Programmes.



(D)

- In the Post Graduate programmes of the University campus, seats are earmarked for the candidates who have secured positions /participation in the State / National / International level sports competitions. Admission under this will be given as per the criteria set through the competent committee nominated by the Vice Chancellor. Candidates have to necessarily indicate it at the place specified in the application form. If the admission of a candidate with such option is not done on merit basis, then the person will be issued information for admission in sports quota through proper channel. Applicants shall have to appear with a State / National / International level Sports Certificate. Under the sports quota also, the merit will be formed and followed for admission as per the faculty-wise allocated seats. This facility is available for the University Campus only.

(E)

- The following number of seats is allocated in Post Graduate programmes under Sports Quota in various faculties to the candidates who have secured a place /participation in State / National/ International level sports;

6. Eligibility for admission in different post graduate programmes:

- Only those students who have passed the graduation or its equivalent examination will be eligible for admission to PG programmes. Students appearing for graduation or its equivalent examination in the year 2024, can also appear in the Post Graduate Entrance Tests, however, at the time of admission they have to produce the passing certificate/mark sheet of the qualifying examination.
- CGPA corresponding to the pass percentage required for admission in different Post Graduation programmes shall also be acceptable for admission.
- Eligibility rules for LLB, LL.M, B.P.Ed., and M.Ed. programmes are different. So, interested candidates must thoroughly see the PG Brochure/programme specific brochures.
- Qualified candidates can claim admission in any one of the offered Post Graduation programmes.

LLB:	Graduation in any discipline from a recognized institution with at least 45% marks for general (unreserved) Category candidates, 42% marks for OBC candidates and 40% marks for SC/ST candidates.
MA Economics:	Economics as a subject in BA III or Mathematics/ Statistics as a subject in BSc III or Commerce Graduate with minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates.
MSc Physics:	All graduates who have passed B.Sc. examination with Physics as a subject or have studied Electronics/ Computer Science/Mathematics/Statistics in B.SC. or have done B.Tech. with minimum 45% marks for general and OBC applicants and 40% marks for SC/ST Candidates are eligible for admission in MSc Physics.
MSc Electronics:	Electronics/ Physics as subject in UG third year with minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates.

BSc in Biological Sciences/ BSc Home Science with Food and Nutrition as paper or subject with minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates.

MSc Zoology:

Those candidates would be eligible who have passed BSc Life Science/ BSc Biology/ BSc Zoology from any recognized University with Zoology/Life Science/Biology as main subject with minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates.

MSc Environmental Science:

Those candidates would be eligible who have passed (Life Science)/ (Biology) from any recognized University. In graduation (third year), the candidate must have opted for Botany /Zoology/Industrial Microbiology/ Microbiology/Biotechnology with minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates.

MSc Aquaculture:

Graduate from any recognized university life sciences as principal subject with minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates.

**MSc Biotechnology**

A minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates in Bachelor's Degree (Sciences, Medical and Applied Medical Sciences/ Health and Allied Health/Agriculture/ Food Sciences/ Bio-Sciences.

MSc Bioinformatics:

A minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates in Bachelor's Degree (Sciences, Medical and Applied Medical Sciences/ Health and Allied Health/Agriculture/ Food Sciences/ Bio-Sciences.

MSc Plant Biotechnology:

A minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates in Bachelor's Degree (Sciences, Medical and Applied Medical Sciences/ Health and Allied Health/Agriculture/ Food Sciences/ Bio-Sciences.

**MA/MSc
Mathematics:**

Mathematics as a subject in UG III Year or B.Tech./BCA with minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates.

**MA/MSc Defence and
Strategic Studies**

Graduation or any equivalent degree from any recognised university/Institution with minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST category candidates.

MSc Agriculture:

BSc Agriculture (for MSc Horticulture BSc Agriculture and BSc Horticulture) with minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates.

MA/MSc Statistics

Statistics/Mathematics as a subject in UG III Year or B.Tech./BCA with minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates.

M Com:

Graduate in any discipline with minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST candidates.

LLM:

LL.B. or B.A.LL.B. from a recognized institution with at least 50% marks for general (unreserved) Category and OBC candidates. This rule of minimum percentage does not apply for SC/ST candidates. Candidates having less than 45% marks in graduation level but having 45% or more marks at post graduation level are also eligible for admission in LLB three year programme.

**M Ed:**

Minimum aggregated 50% marks or equivalent grade is required in any one of the following examinations for the applicants;

- B.Ed.
- L.T.
- B.A. B.Ed. (Integrated)
- B.Sc. B.Ed. (Integrated)
- B. El. Ed.
- Graduation with D. El. Ed

NOTE:

1. This minimum percentage shall be relaxed by 5% in case of OBC, SC, ST and DIVYANG (Physically Handicapped) applicants.

2. Aggregate percentage (theory + practical) of following degrees and diploma shall be entered on application form;

- B.Ed.
- L.T.
- B.A. B.Ed. (Integrated)
- B. Sc. B. Ed (Integrated)
- B. El. Ed.
- D. El. Ed. (not graduation)



**B.P.Ed.:**

Bachelor's degree in any discipline with at least 50% marks and at least participation in Inter College/Inter- Zonal/ District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Government of India.

OR

Bachelor's degree in Physical Education with 45% marks.

OR

Bachelor's degree in any discipline with at least 45% marks with Physical Education as a compulsory/elective subject.

OR

Bachelor's degree with 45% marks and having participated in National/Inter University/ State Competitions or secured 1st /2nd or 3rd position in Inter-College/Inter-Zonal/District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Government of India.

OR

Bachelor's degree with participation in International Competitions or secured I, II & III position in National/Inter University competition in sports and games as recognised by the respective federations: AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

OR

Graduation with 45% marks and at least three years teaching experience (For deputed in-service candidate i. e. trained physical education teachers/coaches).

NOTE:

(i). Minimum 45% marks for General and OBC category candidates and minimum 40% marks for SC/ST category candidates is minimum essential eligibility requirement for admission in all Post Graduate programmes except LL.B., L.L.M, M.Ed. and B.P.Ed.





6-A. Other rules for admission in LL.B. First Semester:

- (i). Admission process will be conducted according to the latest available criteria of Bar Council of India.
- (ii). In order to get admission in three years L.L.B. course, applicants of the General, O.B.C. and S.C., S.T. categories will have to achieve minimum 45%, 42% and 40% respectively in their final year examination (U.G./P.G.) required for eligibility according to the rules of the Bar Council of India.
- (iii). L.L.B. Three Years) is a full-time regular programme. Students cannot take admission in any other course (Degree/Diploma/Research etc.) of this or any other University/Institution. Such candidates who are government employees or students of any other course will not be considered eligible for this programme.
- (iv). Admission will be granted on the basis of the rank in the merit list together with the achievement of the minimum marks in LL.B. Entrance Examination which is 35% for General candidates, 25% for O.B.C., 20% for S.C. and 15% for the S.T. category applicants.



**6-B. Other rules for admission in LL.M. First Semester:**

- (i) LL.B. or B.A.LL.B. from a recognized institution with at least 50% marks for general (unreserved) Category and OBC candidates whereas this rule will not be effective in case of SC/ST applicants.
- (ii) The students who have appeared in LL.B. last semester examination can also take part in LL.M. Entrance Examination on condition that they will have to produce certificate of their minimum educational qualification at the time of admission otherwise they shall not be entitled for admission in whatsoever conditions.
- (iii) Gap of unlimited years after passing the qualifying examination is allowed to appear in LL.M. Entrance Examination.
- (iv) General rules of the University shall be applicable for deciding reservation, weightage and minimum pass percentage (if any) in admission.
- (v) The medium of teaching and learning is Hindi, however, basic knowledge of English is essential for the purpose.
- (vi) All the applicants who have applied for improvement/ back paper/ back semester etc. and have been found eligible for LL.M. Entrance Examination will have to produce their improved/ passed marksheet to the admission committee. If the result of these examinations has not been declared by the time, such applicants shall not be able to get admission.
- (vii) The applicants who have passed their qualifying examination before 2024 will have to produce an affidavit for the declaration of the gap at the time of admission. Admission committee will permit such applicants for admission only when its members are fully satisfying with the reason cited in the affidavit.
- (viii) Admission in LL.M. will be granted on the basis of the rank in the merit list together with achievement of minimum marks in LL.M. Entrance Examination which is 35% for General applicants & EWS, 25% for OBC, 20% for SC and 15% for ST category applicants.
- (ix) At the time of admission every applicant will have to submit a Character Certificate issued by the institution, last attended. This rule will also be applicable for the students of DDU Gorakhpur, Gorakhpur.
- (x) If any candidate has passed graduation through correspondence from any University, he/she will be allowed for admission only when such an applicant will produce a certificate issued by the Registrar of that University, to the effect that the UG correspondence degree of that University is equivalent to the regular UG degree of this university.
- (xi). If any applicant fails to present himself/ herself with all his/ her original documents before the admission committee at the appointed time on the prescribed date, his/ her admission will stand cancelled.
- (xii). The University reserves the right to deny admission to any applicant without citing the reason or to make desired circumstantial changes in the rules of admission.

8. Syllabus of Entrance Test for various Post Graduate Programmes Structure shall be uploaded on university website/ admission portal soon.

9. Admission Procedure:

1. Entrance test dates for various programmes shall soon be available on the university official website.
2. Admission to the Postgraduate programmes available in the University campus and colleges shall be done through online counselling.
3. Applicants can fill the choice of the colleges in order of preference within stipulated time after the declaration of result of entrance test.
4. Candidates found eligible shall be given provisional admission based on their choice of programme, entrance test score and permissible weightage. Admission shall be given strictly according to the order of merit and the availability of seats.
5. The list of students with allotment to the University /Colleges will be made available on the university website in accordance with the respective programmes.
6. At the time of admission, the candidate has to present all the original certificates along with their self-attested photo copies (Aadhaar card, mark sheets, Caste Certificate, Weightage certificate, Disability/Ex-serviceman/dependent of freedom fighter) Kashmir displaced Kashmiri Pandits residing in Kashmir valley/Ward of Kashmiri Hindu family/Kargil martyrs, Divyang certificate, Transfer Certificate, Character Certificate provided by the Principal of the institution last attended, etc.) to the Admission Committee. Candidates who have passed from other boards /institutions (like CBSE, ICSE and other boards) besides Uttar Pradesh Secondary Education Council will also have to bring a Migration Certificate
7. It will be mandatory for the candidates to get their name registered in the department after submission of required fee in the concerned faculty office/college; otherwise, their admission is liable to be cancelled.
8. Original certificates regarding details of any category, sub category or weightage filled in by the candidates in the application form shall have to be produced at the time of admission. In case of the candidate not being able to produce the original certificates, he / she shall be deprived of the benefit and the merit list is liable to be changed.
9. The candidate will have to declare to the effect that there is no criminal suit against her / him and in future if any FIR is registered, his/ her admission shall be liable to be cancelled.



11. It is compulsory for the candidates to produce the print copy of their application form and admit card at the time of admission and so they are advised to keep them safe.
12. All the forms / records related to the entrance test will be preserved only for six months after the completion of the entrance test.
13. The candidate shall be considered a regular student of the university / college from the date of payment of his/her admission fees after counselling fee and registration at the concerned office.
14. Admission related rules are as per the University Act, Statutes & Ordinances. The admission committee may cancel the admission of any candidate without assigning any reason.
15. In case of any discrepancy in relation to admission, decision of the admission committee shall prevail.
16. Once admitted and having appeared / failed in the examination of a particular class in the university/ college, a student shall not be readmitted in the same class but can appear as an Ex-student in the Examination.
17. The University reserves the right to amend the rules regarding admission procedure, number of seats and fee structure.

10. Important and relevant instructions for Entrance Test:

1. The OMR answer sheet will be given along with the question booklet, on which the answer will have to be marked. Only the answer sheet (OMR) will be evaluated.
2. Each question will have four alternative answers, out of which candidates have to choose the correct answer by shading the circle of the choice with black/blue ball pen against that question number.
