- 4. In semester V & VI two courses (05 credits each) are offered for 3 years UG Degree n faculty of Arts with a total of 132 credits.
- 5. In semester VII & VIII 05 courses are offered (04 credits each) for 4 year UG Degree Hon's with a total of 172 credits & 4 year UG Degree Hon's & Research with a total of 172 credits.
- 6. But students those who secure a minimum of 75% marks (CGPA7.5) in First Six Semesters and opt for 4 years Degree Hon's with Research with a total of 172 Credits, in VIII semester they will require to take only 2 theory courses (04 credit each) & they will complete a Research Project of 12 credits
