16. Transformative initiatives as Head of the Department

Professor Ajay Kumar Shukla, currently serving as the Head of the Department of English at Deen Dayal Upadhyay Gorakhpur University, has been a beacon of innovation and leadership. His initiatives have significantly enhanced the academic environment, fostering a culture of excellence and holistic development among students. Below is an in-depth look at his remarkable initiatives and their impact.

1. Organized Mock Interviews for Higher Education Aspirants

Understanding the crucial role of interviews in the admission process for higher education, Professor Shukla organized a series of mock interviews tailored for students aspiring to advance their academic careers. This initiative provided students with a simulated interview environment, helping them develop confidence and refine their interview skills. The success of this initiative is evident from the fact that 7 out of 10 students who participated in these mock interviews secured positions in esteemed institutions. This effort not only boosted

the students' confidence but also prepared them for real-world challenges.

2. Peer Teachers Concept

Professor Shukla introduced the peer teachers concept to promote collaborative learning and peer-to-peer mentorship within the department. This innovative approach encouraged senior students to assist their juniors in understanding complex concepts and coursework. By fostering a supportive learning environment, this initiative enhanced the overall academic performance and created a sense of community among students. Peer teaching also developed leadership and teaching skills among senior students, preparing them for future academic and professional roles.

3. Launch of "Sahitya Vimarsh" Monthly Magazine

In an effort to provide students with a platform to showcase their literary talents, Professor Shukla launched a monthly magazine titled "Sahitya Vimarsh." This magazine, which has seen the publication of seven editions so far, is edited by students under his supervision. "SahityaVimarsh" serves as a vibrant forum for students to express their thoughts, engage in literary critique, and develop editorial skills. This initiative has not only enhanced students' writing and critical thinking abilities but also instilled a sense of responsibility and pride in their work. 12 issues have so far been brought out.

4. Formation of "Discourse" Literary Club

To encourage holistic development and foster a love for literature, Professor Shukla established "Discourse," a literary club within the department. This club organizes a variety of activities, including literary discussions, debates, poetry readings, and guest lectures. Through these activities, students are exposed to diverse literary perspectives and are encouraged to think critically and creatively. The literary club has become a cornerstone of the department's extracurricular activities, enriching the academic experience and promoting a vibrant literary culture.

5. Establishment of Research Forum

Recognizing the importance of research in academia, Professor Shukla established a research forum dedicated to supporting and encouraging research activities among students and faculty. This forum provides resources and guidance for research projects, facilitating collaboration and the sharing of ideas. It also organizes seminars, workshops, and conferences to promote scholarly dialogue and dissemination of research findings. The research

forum has significantly contributed to the department's academic output, fostering a culture of inquiry and intellectual growth.

6. Compulsory PowerPoint Presentations for PG Students

To ensure that postgraduate students are proficient in using modern technology, Professor Shukla made PowerPoint presentations a compulsory part of their curriculum. This initiative aims to enhance students' presentation skills and their ability to effectively communicate complex ideas using digital tools. By integrating technology into the learning process, this initiative has equipped students with essential skills that are highly valued in both academic and professional settings.

7. Induction Programme

The Special Induction Programme, spearheaded by Prof. Ajay Kumar Shukla as Head of the Department, was designed to welcome and orient newly admitted students. This initiative aims to familiarize students with the various course structures, facilitating their academic and professional development. A key feature of the programme is the introduction to the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), enabling students to understand and navigate the flexibility and options within their academic journey effectively. The programme also includes interactive sessions with senior students, faculty members, and research scholars, fostering a supportive community and providing insights into departmental culture and expectations.

This initiative was highly successful, significantly enhancing students' exam performance and boosting overall academic achievement.

9. NET Preparation Classes. Conducted NET preparation classes at the Departmental level which got high success rate.
10. Initiated a plantation drive under the initiative **"My Campus, My Pride and My Responsibility"** and published a poetry collection titled **"Shabd and Stanza: Bilingual Creative Voices,"** featuring poems by student.
