MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University (KKSU), Ramtek, is an institution dedicated to the advanced learning of Sanskrit which is the First Sanskrit University of Maharashtra. The University, along with providing regular course works, KKSU is unique in nature which focuses on a modern approach to the Sanskrit language. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gorakhpur University (DDUGU), founded in 1957, is the first university in Uttar Pradesh to emerge as a leading higher-studies centre after Independence. It has earned an A++ accreditation from NAAC for its relentless pursuit of its motto, "Let the noble thoughts come to us from all directions," which reflects its openness to diverse perspectives, cultures, and values in its academic and organizational spheres. The university bears the name of the eminent political philosopher, Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya. It has successfully implemented a range of innovative schemes and programs to impart holistic education to its students. The university is renowned nationwide for its quality research, outstanding teaching and learning processes, national and international awards, sports activities and achievements, involvement in outreach and extension activities, strong student support system, placements in reputed government and private organizations, and transparent and effective governance.

Article 1:

KKSU has signed a MoU with DDUGU. The purpose of MoU is to undertake training programs, Students and Faculty Exchange Programs, Skill development programs, to conduct short term courses in mutual, Study and Editing of Manuscripts, Translation works, joint research, site visits and development of all such programs which will benefit students and teachers of both the institutes. The goal of this collaboration is to fulfill the aims and objectives of National Education Policy 2020 (NEP-2020) and meet the rapidly growing educational need by leveraging mutual capabilities.

DDUGU and KKSU agree to explore the possibility of engaging in the following mode of collaboration.

- a. Exchange of information on Research and Design Students and Faculty Exchange Programs, Teaching learning materials, Manuscripts and other sources relevant of Sanskrit and its allied subjects through meetings and discussions and direct contribution through designs projects. Also, Development of educational and training programs for institutional development. Experiential learning through Hands on training and workshops Students will be encouraged to participate in skilling programs to gain knowledge through learning by doing.
- **b. Joint organization** Joint organizations of seminars workshops on respective field while extending invitation to each other's contact to participate therein.
- c. Sharing expertise Providing expertise in upgradation of teaching-learning and research skills along with Exchange of documentation, research materials, publication, and information in fields of mutual interest.
- d. Under this MoU CDOE will start in mutual subject to obtaining the approval from UGC, Govt. of Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh and concerned authorities.
- e. Promotion & Propagation of Sanskrit & its allied subjects will be carried out mutually through seminars / workshops / conference / symposium etc.

Article 2:

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of Three years commencing from effective date June 12, 2024 Both parties may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after necessary review.

Either party may terminate this MoU by giving written notice of six months in advance to the other party.

No amendment or modification of this MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties and their representatives specifically stating the same to be amended in this MoU. The modification / changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made / executed unless otherwise agreed to.

Article 3:

Once terminated, neither party will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other party may suffer.

In case there is a dispute relating to any aspect of academic and research cooperation, both the parties shall jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.

Article 4:

This MoU is not legally binding to either of the parties and does not subject them to any liabilities for the breach of contract, whether material or minor of contract or any other liability under the national applicable law.
