## **Prominent Alumni**

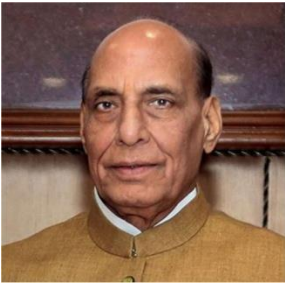

### **Sri Rajnath Singh, Hon. Defense Minister of India**



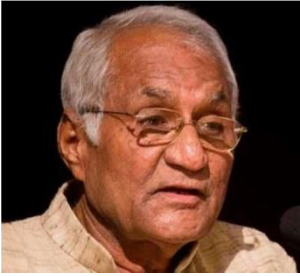

## **Infrastructure**

DDU Gorakhpur University is located in Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh. The University of Gorakhpur is a teaching and residential-cum-affiliating University. It is about two kilometers from the downtown to the east and almost walking distance from railway station to the south. Separate hostels for boys and girls, library, sports, laboratories, guesthouse, etc are the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gorakhpur University facilities. A library of DDU Gorakhpur University has a collection of reference books, magazines, dictionaries, directories, etc. Students can visit the library whenever they are free. Separate hostels are available for boys and girls. Warden is available to take care of the hostel students and ensures that the students get a clean environment to stay. Indoor and outdoor sports facilities are also provided to the students. DDU Gorakhpur University cafeteria provides nutritious food to the students. It is the best place for the students to spend their leisure time with their friends. The whole campus of DDU Gorakhpur University is wifi enabled. Laboratories are available for the students so that they can have hands-on experience.

## **Samwad Bhawan**



Cultural activities are an intrinsic part of university life of the students of the University. The concerned authorities always endeavor to provide a platform for enhancing the creativity and grooming the personality of the students. University has a fully air-conditioned auditorium, Samvad Bhawan, with a seating capacity of 250, equipped with modern amenities. It is used for various cultural and academic activities of the University and its Departments.

## **The Central Library**



The Central Library of Deen Dayal Upadhyaya, Gorakhpur University was instituted in the very first year of establishment of the university. This library building is set up in about four thousand square meters area where approximately four lakhs of text material is stored. It works for the services of more than fifteen thousand students of the five faculties of the University, teachers, employees and researchers coming here for their research work.

There is a main textbook collection room CTBS (Central Text Book Section) in this building from where the text books are distributed to the students of UG and PG level. The Nehru Hall or the reading room is located on the ground floor, in which the students' read newspapers, magazines and various general books. Apart from this, there is also a Stack section on the ground floor envisaged for teachers and research scholars.

There is a huge reference room on the first floor which is also known as Gandhi Hall. Excellent reference books like dictionaries, Encyclopedias, Directories, Bibliographies, Year-Books, Almanacs, Gazetteers, guide-books, maps, atlases, Handbooks, manuals and statistical source set care placed here. There is also a research Journal Section on this floor. Internet-equipped computers for teachers and researchers and special Braille enabled computers have also been installed for visually impaired people in the library.

## **Museums**

### **The Science Museum**



The Science Museum in Department of Zoology, Pant Block, D.D.U. Gorakhpur University, Gorakhpur is one of the major attractions among students of University, affiliated colleges and schools of Gorakhpur. It shows cases the diversity of animals from Protozoa to Mammals. This rich collection of rare animal specimens in the museum are laid out in a taxonomic fashion. The museum was established with inception of the department in the year 1958 for student teaching and education. The collections are result of over 62 years of teaching and research activities of students and staff. The museum's huge collection contains about 10000 specimens as various skeletons of Mammals, Aves, Reptiles, Amphibians, Fishes, stuffed body of various birds and preserved specimen collection of poisonous and non-poisonous snakes, marine and freshwater fishes, mollusks, corals and other rare animals offering an insight into the biological diversity. The museum houses a life size, complete stuffed body of ostrich and a rich collection of insects as its pride possession. The museum with collection of an extensive range of specimens aims to preserve and showcase the diversity in animal kingdom with a display about evolutionary biology. Besides the skeleton, preserved specimens, museum also stores model so frère and extinct animals and charts to display anatomy, lifecycle of different animals from protozoa to mammals for students. It remains open from 10.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M. on all working days of the Universit

## Ancient History Museum



The Department of Ancient History, Archaeology and Culture houses Arts Museum (Acharya Vishwambar Saran Pathak Museum) of the University that contains a rich collection of lower Palaeolithic, middle Palaeolithic and upper Paleolithic tools, Mesolithic and Neolithic tools, rare gold, silver and bronze coins of the earliest period, the Gupta and Kushan periods and many objects of archaeological importance acquired through excavations in nearby places.



## Purvanchal Sangrahalaya

Symbols of history and culture are the pioneers of living societies. Museums are not just the buildings but also for important communication between past and present. In the same spirit, the concept of Purvanchal Museum was conceived in the year 2012 at Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gorakhpur University to keep the regional culture and heritage memorable. The brilliant thinker and the then Rajya Sabha M.P. Late Mohan Singh, through M.P. fund, made a special contribution of ₹2crores to make the museum tangible. Nearly 2 years later, on 14 May 2016, the museum building was inaugurated by three women M.P., Mrs. Jaya Bachchan, Mrs. Dimple Yadav and Mrs. Kanaklata Singh. After this, the exercise of informing the museum and opening for culture lovers started. It was duly started by Vice Chancellor Prof. Vijay Krishna Singh on 23 rd May, 2018.

In the coming days, the museum will include the folk culture and equipment of this region and there are plans to show case short films on various occasions. Prof. Nandita Singh (Department of English and Modern European Languages) is the present director of the museum.

## Guest House



The University guest house is one of the most important constituents of the university campus and plays a significant role in the academic and corporate lives of the university. Built in the 60s and expanded in 2002, The university guesthouse presently consists of three blocks-The Old guesthouse, Shivam Block and the academic staff college guest house. The main guest house comprising the old guest house and the Shivam block includes 28 rooms-one VVIP suite, 02 VIP rooms, 18 AC rooms and 7 non-AC rooms. Besides it also houses a well-furnished multipurpose hall, a meeting hall and a dining hall with an attached kitchen. Apart from these the guesthouse also has too large dormitories. The academic staff College guest house consists of 29 rooms to cater to the participants of the orientation, refresher and short-term courses organised by the human resources development centre (earlier, academic staff College). Recently the guesthouse got a much-required facelift that included the beautification of guest House lawns, installation of new TV sets in the rooms, installation of the paintings and statues reflecting the history and culture of the Gorakhpur region.

## Media Centre



To support the academic vision and mission of the university, Media Center has been establishing at Deeksha bhawan. It will maintain facilities, materials, and equipment for the production, distribution and utilization of instructional media. It will serve as resource center, learning laboratory, teaching center, service agency and coordinating agency with all basic modern educational facilities. Center will be having Educational Film production studio, Lecture capturing studio, Photoshop animation & graphics laboratory and smart instructional classroom. Educational Film production studio will include Studio, greenroom, control room, audio-video mixing room. This facility will be utilized for teaching students on film production under different courses, production of short films on educational & social issues to aware civil society, to produce and broadcast news on relevant events.
