



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

**DEEN DAYAL UPADHYAYA GORAKHPUR UNIVERSITY,
GORAKHPUR**

AND

**DISTRICT INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION AND TRAINING,
GORAKHPUR**

The Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MOU) is made on26.11...of the month of June in the year 2024 between Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gorakhpur University, Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh having it's head quarter at Gorakhpur (hereinafter referred to as DDUGU, Called First Party) and the District Institute of Education and Training, Gorakhpur having it's head quarter at Gorakhpur (hereinafter referred to as DIET, Called Second Party)

The parties, having discussed fields of common research interests and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into long-term collaboration for quality education, research and training activities for students and teachers.

1. PURPOSE-

1.1 Collaborate in exchanging information on research and educational programs of mutual interest and provide a common ground for faculties to pursue research on educational planning in the field of their interest.

1.2 Exchange information on Teaching Learning Material and other literature relevant to their educational planning and research programs.

1.3 Jointly organize seminars, conferences and workshops on topics of mutual interest.

1.4 Facilitate invitation of faculties in various training sessions of teachers/faculties.

1.5 Explore the mechanism for providing access of language lab existed in DDUGU to the trainees of DIET Gorakhpur.

1.6 Explore the mechanism for providing facilities of Central Library, DDUGU to faculty members of DIET to enhance their teaching and research capacities.

1.7 To organise and promote Competency Development Programs .

1.8 Find out the possibilities of utilising DIET's expertise in teacher's training, specially for B.El.Ed course (proposed to be run by DDUGU).

2. TERMS OF THIS MEMORANDUM-

2.1 This Memorandum commences on the date specified on the last page of this document, and remains in effect for a period of five years from date of commencement.

2.2 The parties may renew this MOU for additional term by mutual consent.

2.3 Either party may terminate this Memorandum at any time by notifying the other party at least three (3) months prior to the proposed date of termination.

2.4 Termination or expiry of this Memorandum does not affect any legal binding arrangements in effect or continuing following termination or expiry of this Memorandum.

3. COORDINATION OF AGREED ACTIVITIES-

3.1 In order to carry out and fulfill the aims of this Memorandum, each party will appoint a coordinator, who will be responsible for management of the execution and conduct of all activities upon which both the party agrees.

4. JOINT ACTIVITIES –

4.1 Either party may initiate proposals for activities at any time and submit them to the other party for consideration. If the parties agree to implement any proposal, they will enter into a legal binding agreement in corporation suitable.

5.1 Financial implications shall be decided on a case-by-case basis by the parties.

This MOU has been executed in two originals, one of which has been retained by the First Party and the other by the Second Party. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this MOU and represent that they approve, accept and agree to the terms contained herein.
